You will have:

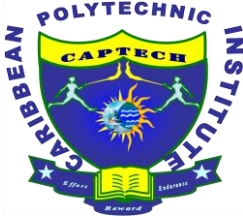
- 1) A Master's degree in Land-Based pathways such as Agriculture, Environmental Science or Horticulture from an accredited university.

- 4) a good understanding of online and distance learning technologies and managed learning environments such as Google Classroom, Moodle, Sakai or Blackboard, or be willing
- 5) experience with remote working
- 6) a level 4 (or above) qualification in education, or be willing

**Personal Management Skills** - You will have excellent English language, computer and information literacy skills.

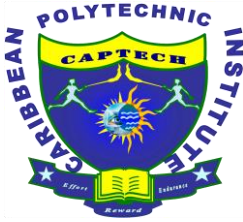


**Subject Matter Expertise** - You will have subject matter expertise in one or more of the following Land and Environment pathways:
